Below are some suggested walking, cycling and ferry routes to help you find your way.

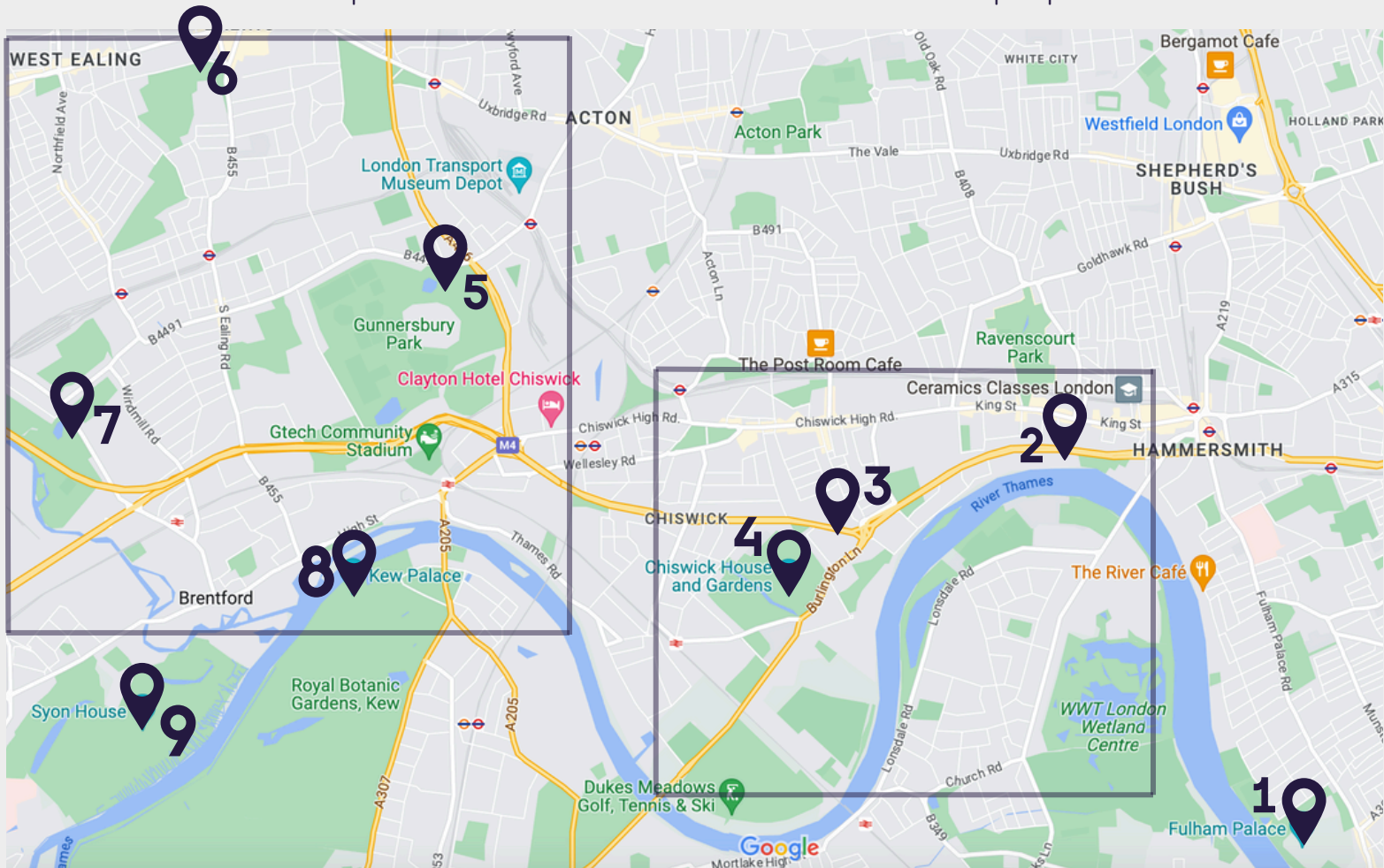

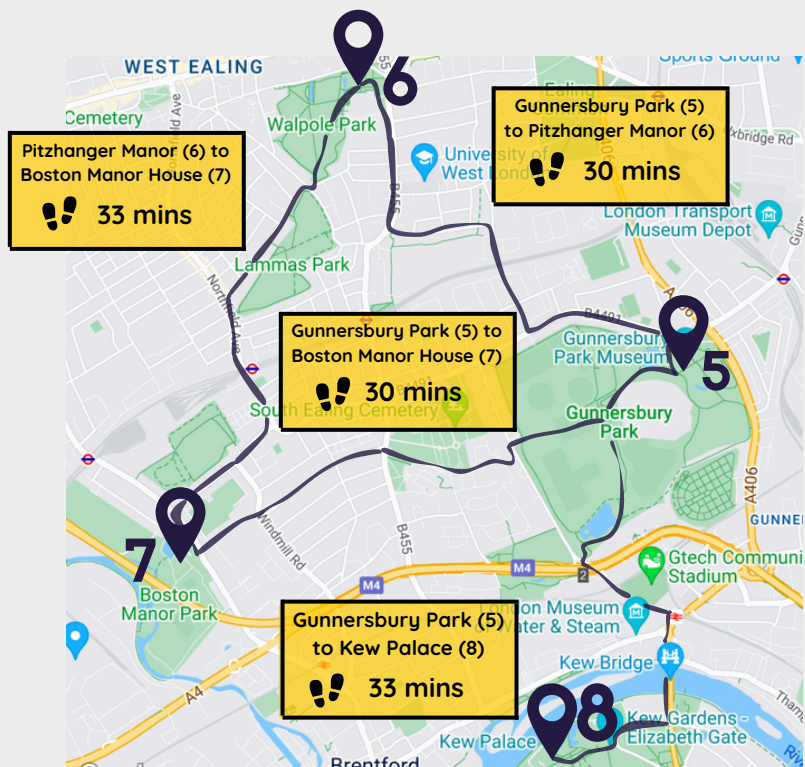
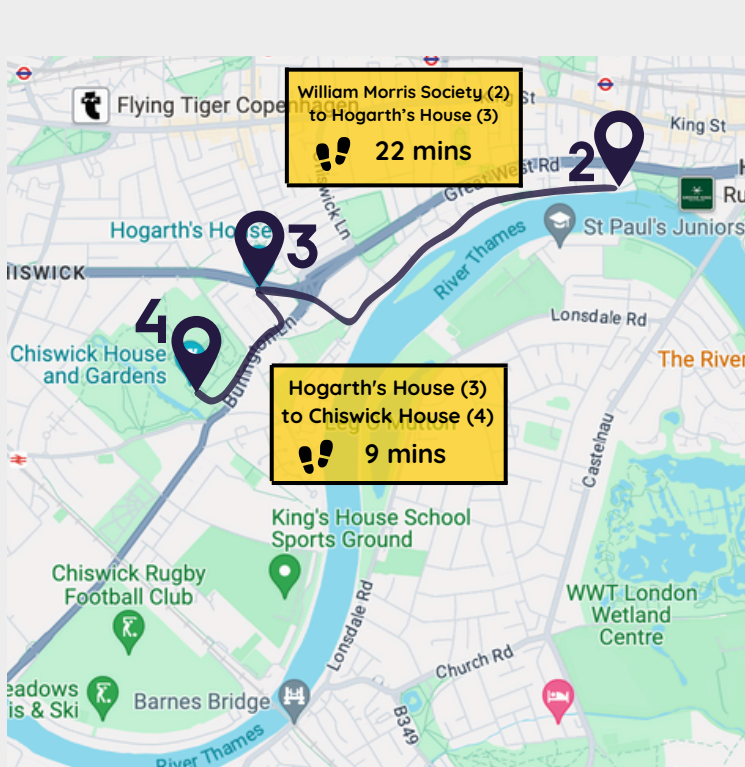

This map shows the locations of our nine eastern properties:



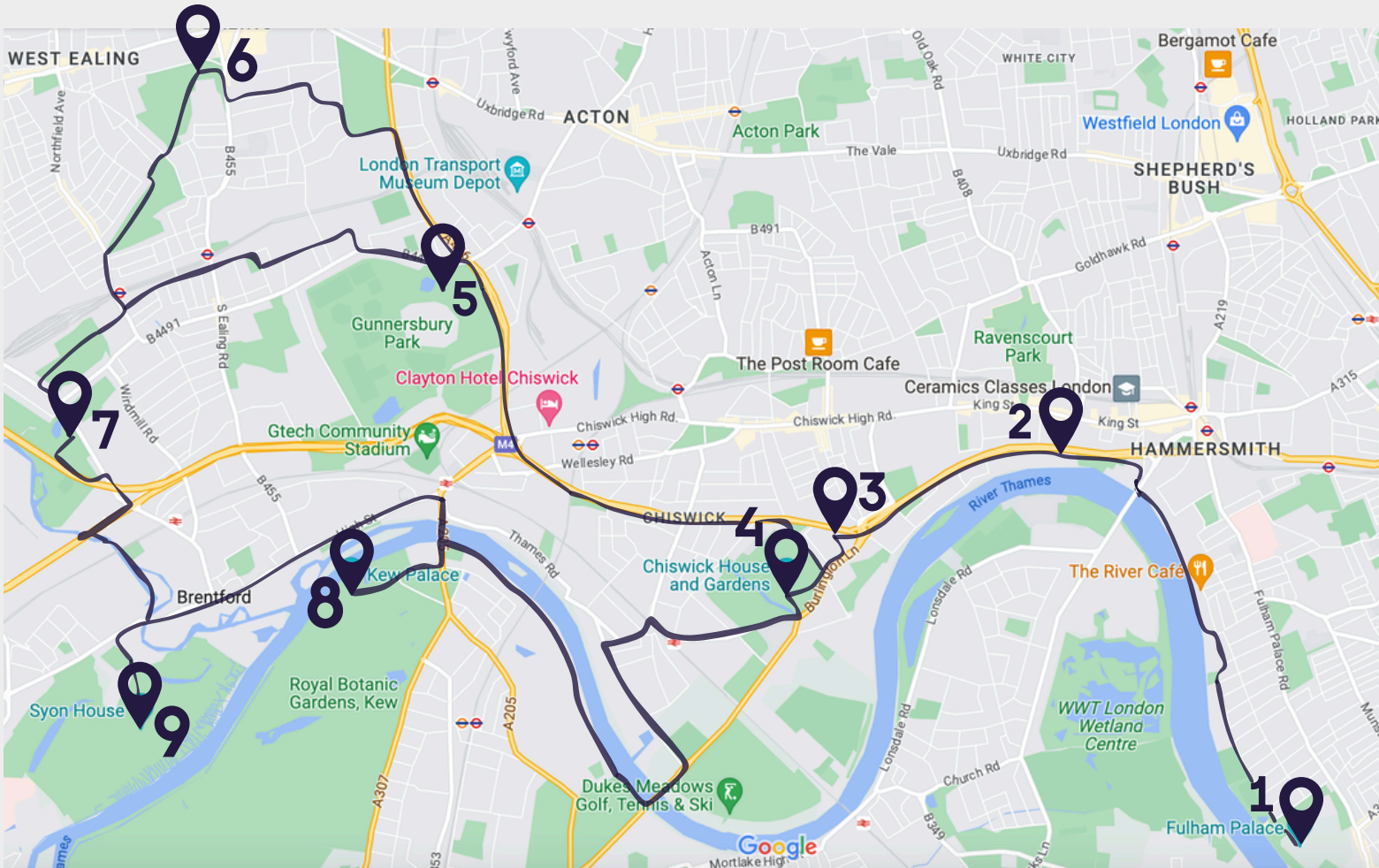
Here are some suggested **walking** routes:

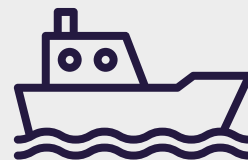

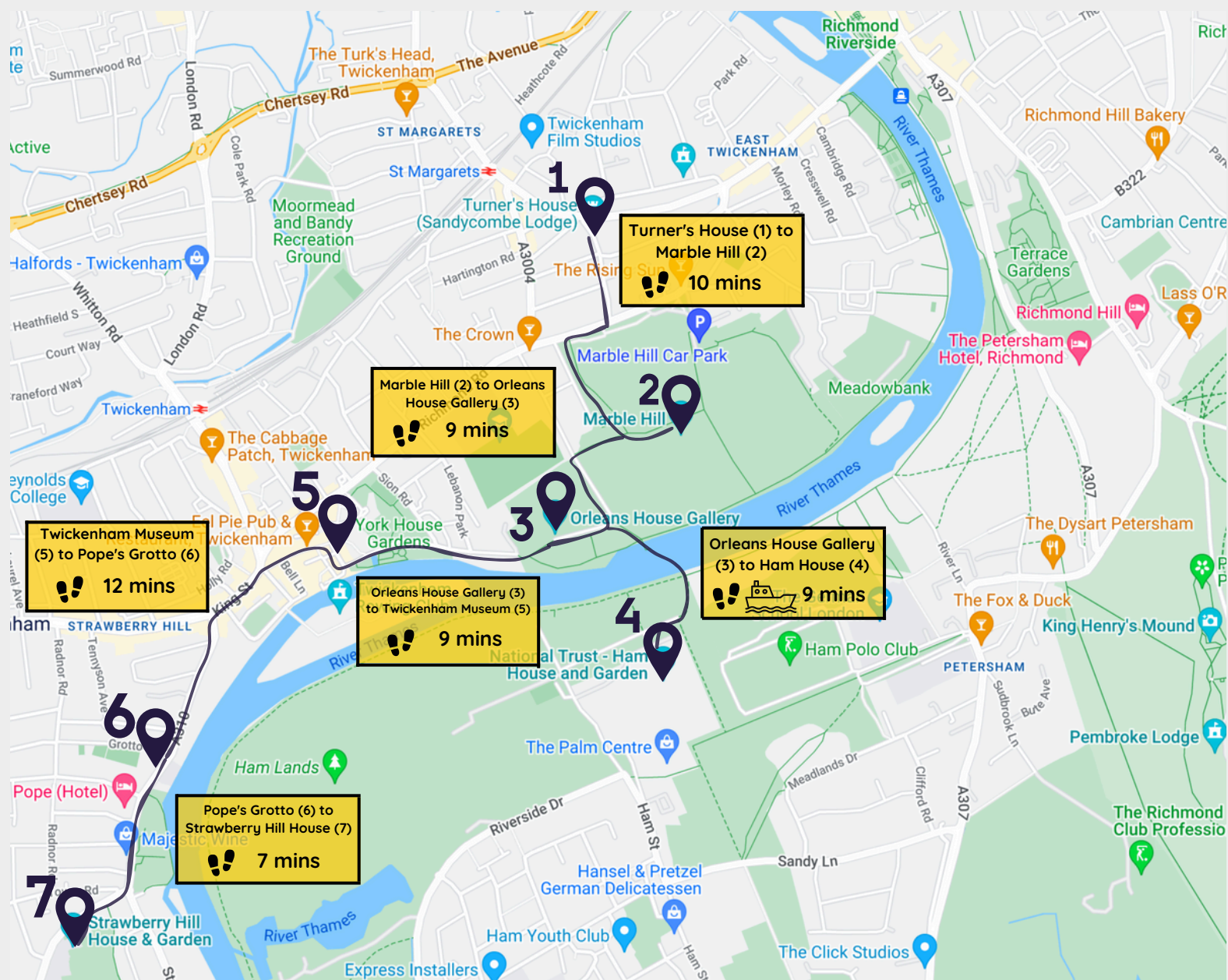


See below for suggested **walking routes** between seven of our western properties.

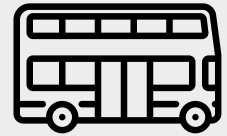
See below for suggested **cycling routes** between our eight western properties.
